QQI LEVEL 6

Communications 6N1950

Monday 7pm – 9pm 10 weeks €170

This mandatory module is transferable across all QQI 6 Major Awards, eg, Early Childhood Studies; Health Services Supervisory Management Skills and Business programmes.

Childhood Social, Legal and Health Studies 6N1945

Thursday 7pm-10pm 10 weeks €200

This module is mandatory for the QQI L6 Major Award in Early Childhood Studies. It will equip the learner with the knowledge, skill and competence in the social and legislative environment of ECCE, enabling the learner to devise, implement and evaluate policies and procedures that support the health and wellbeing of children in the provision and delivery of childcare services.

QQI LEVEL 5

Understanding Mental Health 5N3772

Monday 7.30pm – 9.30pm 10 weeks €150

The purpose of this module is to equip the learner with the knowledge, skill and competence to understand and promote good practice in providing services to individuals with mental health difficulties. The role of the healthcare worker in assisting clients with mental health issues and working as part of the healthcare team will be explored.

Safety & Health @ Work 5N1794

Thursday 7.30pm to 9.30pm 10 weeks €150

This Level 5 module equips learners with the knowledge and skills to be aware of their rights and responsibilities as employees (and employers) to ensure a safe workplace. Legislation, policies and procedures relating to the Health, Safety and Welfare @ Work Act will be explored. This module is transferable across all QQI 5 Major Awards.

Accounting, Manual and Computerised 5N1348

Thursday 7pm-9.30pm 30 hours €180

Following the successful module 'Bookkeeping, Manual & Computerised', this module will outline the principles of accounting, explain a range of accounting terms and standards and enable the learner to carry out a range of accounting procedures utilising both integrated accounting software and manual procedures. Areas addressed include – role of auditors and audit process; preparation of forecasts and budgets; financial statements; extracting final accounts & reports and file management functions. HOBBY/ LEISURE COURSES

GENERAL INTEREST PROGRAMMES:

Web Design; Developing Internet Skills

Monday 7pm – 9pm 4 weeks €60

This four week programme introduces 'weebly' for beginners. Participants will learn to build basic web design. Create a website for various needs – from blogging to business. Basic computer skills an advantage but not essential. Commencing Monday 1st October, 7pm – 9pm. Cost €60.

Brow and Nail Care – Makeup Artistry

Monday 7pm-8.30pm 5 weeks €75

This five week programme is open to individuals of all ages who are interested in learning tips and techniques to maintain their skincare routine, do expert manicures and have a flawless finish when applying makeup and shaping their brows. Materials will be supplied, bring your own makeup brushes.

Cardio Pilates with Yoga

Monday and Thursday 7.15pm to 8.30pm 10 weeks

Cardio Pilates is an energetic fusion of Cardiovascular and Pilates training. This is beneficial to your heart, lungs and musculoskeletal systems. The Yoga component at the end of the class increases strength and flexibility while reducing feelings of stress. The class is broken in to two components: Cardio Pilates – 45minutes; break for 5 minutes and Yoga – 25minutes.

This class will be offered on Monday and Thursday nights for 10 weeks, 7.15pm to 8.30pm, commencing on Monday 24th September.

GENERAL INTEREST PROGRAMMES:

General Parenting Programme

Monday 7pm - 9pm 6 weeks €90

This six week programme is aimed at parents who wish to seek advice, support or information when faced the varying challenges of parenting in the 21st century. The content is flexible and aimed at individuals who are parenting children 0-6 years, primary school children and adolescents. Commencing Monday 24th September, 7pm-9pm.

Introduction to Welding

Monday 4.15pm – 5.45pm 6 weeks €75

This is a six week course introducing children to become proficient in basic yet creative cooking. It is aimed at children in fourth, fifth and sixth class. The course will focus on all of the basic skills involved to create healthy, tasty meals. Course will involve demonstrations, tasting and hands-on cooking experience.
