You will learn about Alternative and augmentative communication (AAC) and the development of a Lámh signing environment. You will receive a Lámh certificate at the end of the day. This course will be run over three Monday nights, totalling 6 hours – it is essential to attend each session to achieve certification.

Lámh Module One Add-on Workshop for Communication Partners of Children using Lámh
